#### HiRISE, la espectacular cámara espacial

Las extraordinarias fotos de este libro fueron tomadas por el Experimento Científico de Imágenes de Alta Resolución (HIRISE, por sus siglas en inglés), la cámara más MRO, que comenzó a orbitar Marte en marzo de 2006.


La HIRISE se eleva a unas 200 millas (322 kilómetros) sobre la superficie de Marte y usa un lente telescópico para tomar fotos con muchos detalles. Transmite las fotos a entusiastas científicos que se encuentran en la Tierra, a 140 millones de millos (225 millones de kilómetros), en promedio, lo cual le toma 15 minutos. La potente HIRISE ha sacado más de 60 000 fotos y continúa airando airededor de Marte y mandando nuevas imágenes a la Tierra.

#### **RUINAS ESPECTACULARES**


La ciudad de Tututepec, donde vivían el príncipe Tidacuy y sus padres, fue fundada en el siglo XI y era la capital política del imperio mixteco, uno de los reinos más poderosos de México en aquellos tiempos. Tututepec fue conquistada por los españoles en 1522.


No se sabe cómo era el Templo Mayor de Tututepec, donde, en el cuento, se hace entrega de la ofrenda a los dioses. Seguramente era tan grande y majestuoso como otras construcciones religiosas de los antiguos mexicanos, varias de las cuales todavía se conservan. Algunas de las más impresionantes son: el Templo de Quetzalcóatl, o Serpiente Emplumada (en Teotihuacan, estado de México); el Templo de Tlahuizcalpantecuhtli, o Señor de la Estrella del Alba (en Tula, Hidalgo); el Edificio de los Cinco Pisos (en Etzná, Campeche), la Pirámide del Adivino, dedicada a Chaac, el dios maya de la Iluvia, en Uxmal (en Santa Elena, Yucatán) y el Templo de Kukulcán en Chichèn Itzá (en Tinum, Yucatán). Kukulcán también se representaba con una serpiente emplumada. Era la versión maya del dios que los aztecas llamaban Quetzalcóatl.
